







NEXT LEVEL!

When you're ready, contact an IATSE organizer to help you get started on your campaign! This can happen



before you talk to a coworker or after you've assembled a group of folx who are willing to do the work to see your union through. We'll help train you on how to win at your studio. Big or small, in-person or remote, we've got a plan and the experience to help you build support and win your union!



Build Supermajority Support



We'll meet regularly to check progress and strategize how to talk to your coworkers. Some folx you may know, but others you might not! You might be in person, hybrid, or fully remote. Who is a part management, and who is an eligible voter? How do we reach everyone to get them informed? We've got the tools and resources to reach everyone!

File for Your Union!

FINAL STAGES....

Now it's time to demand your union! Once a super-majority of co-workers have signed confidential authorization cards to join IATSE, we will give the employer options: agree to voluntarily recognize your union schedule an election through the National Labor Relations Board. Keep the momentum going! Talk to co-worker and act like union to demand your right to a collective voice!

Voluntary Recognition or NLRB Election?

BEAT THE BOSS LEVEL

If your employer forces us into an election to certify your union, this gives them time to launch an anti-union campaign. Be prepared for the divisive tactics of misinformation and threats sold to the employer by 'union avoidance consultants'. Stay focused on creating a sustainable future at work for all your co-workers! Remember, you get to vote on whether or not you want to form a union, not the boss! We strategize with you during our organizing phase to secure our support through this difficult period to win at the ballot box.

THREATS - Threats of job loss, demotion, studio closure & more INTERROGATIONS - Questioning you about union activity PROMISES - "We could give you that raise without a union" SURVIELLANCE - Spying on you to find out about union work Are all illegal under the NLRA!
